Mr. Klug's Corner

Mr. Tschudy's chapel message Wednesday focused on Genesis 3:1-7, where Adam and Eve faced temptation in the Garden of Eden. He used the Jelly Belly BeanBoozled game as a fun but powerful illustration of temptation. In the game, two jelly beans looked exactly the same, but one tasted good while the other tasted terrible. Mr. Tschudy had two students volunteer to play, showing how temptation can look appealing on the outside but lead to disappointment or regret once we give in. He compared this to how Satan tempted Eve, making sin look harmless and even desirable. Mr. Tschudy reminded us that temptation often hides the truth and that we need to trust God's Word to tell right from wrong. Just like with the jelly beans, what seems sweet at first can turn out bitter in the end. His message challenged us to resist temptation and stay close to God through His word and prayer. However, when we do fall into temptation, we know God's grace offers forgiveness through the sacrifice of His son.
