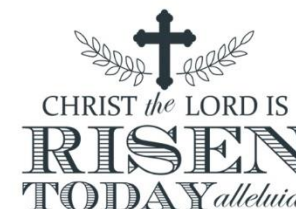
#### **TAKE YOUR PICK FROM OUR SUNDAY BOUQUET OF BIBLE STUDIES –**

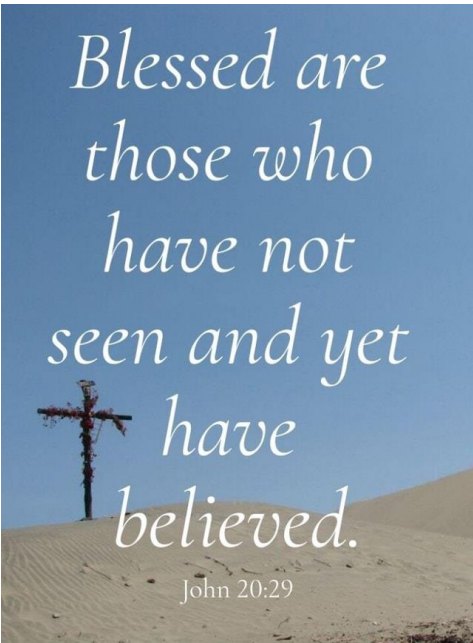
